THE 26TH ANNUAL MAINE STATE FEIS

SATURDAY JULY 25TH, 2026

ENTRIES

- All entries must be submitted prior to July 15th, 2026.
- Entries submitted after this date are subject to a \$30 late fee.
- Entries close on July 20th, 2026 at 6pm. Additional entries after this point will be accepted on a case-by-case basis and incur a \$50 late fee.
- Changes made after July 15th and before July 20th will be accepted with a \$20 change fee.
- No changes will be accepted after July 20th, 2026.
- No entries will be accepted by phone or on the day of the feis.
- **Payment: After registering on FeisWeb all fees must be paid online.**
- **Fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.**
- If all fees are not paid at the time of registration, the entry will be deleted to free a spot for another dancer- no exceptions.

LOCAL RULES

- Awards will be presented in proportion to the number of entries in each competition and to the degree of proficiency shown.
- Carlene Stillson and the Stillson School of Irish Dance, The Town of South Portland, and the Feis committee will not be held responsible for personal injury, loss of property, etc.
- There will be no coolers allowed on the premises. Refreshments will be available at the feis.
- Closing date for entries is July 15th, 2026. All entries received after that date are subject to a \$30 late fee per family.
- Entries will be not accepted after July 20th, 2026 at 6pm.
- Competition numbers must be printed **PRIOR** to the feis. They will **NOT** be available the day of.
- The feis committee reserves the right to combine or split competitions based on the number of dancers.
- Dance choices for Prelim and Open must be indicated on entry.
- **NO VIDEO CAMERAS ALLOWED-** except for pre-beginner, beginner, and advanced beginner categories.
- All competitors must be pupils of a TCRG or ADCRG registered with members of CLRG.
- The Feis Committee reserves the right to deny entry to any dancer or spectator.

*ADULT DANCERS

*Are classified as competitions for dancers who:

- 1) Have not taken Irish Dancing lessons as a juvenile and must be at least 18 years of age on January 1st, 2026
- 2) May have taken lessons as a juvenile but have not competed in any competition, solo or teams, feisanna or Oireachtai, except competitions specifically designated for adults within the past 5 years, and must be at least 18 years of age as of January 1st, 2026.
